- Prioritizing and protecting the 98,000 jobs and \$174 billion in annual economic impact for the region generated by Port operations.
- Enhancing infrastructure for the movement of goods and protecting access to the Port of Oakland.
- Promoting resources to help Port stakeholders reach their sustainability goals.

Each candidate will provide a brief statement on O-MAST's priorities and their intentions regarding the Port if elected. Stakeholders will have the opportunity to mingle with candidates and ask questions both before and after statements are given.
